

How to Form an LLC in Wyoming Yourself (2026 Costs and Steps)

Quick answer

The total state cost to file online is \$100 plus a 2.4% credit card processing fee (minimum \$1). File your Articles of Organization with the Wyoming Secretary of State, Business Division at <https://wyobiz.wyo.gov/Business/RegistrationInstr.aspx>. Online filings result in an entity that is active immediately.

Step 1: Check that your LLC name is available

Search the Wyoming Secretary of State's business name records before filing to ensure your desired name is available.

Step 2: Choose a registered agent

You may serve as your own registered agent if you are at least 18 years old, reside in Wyoming, and have a physical Wyoming address (not a PO box, drop box, mail forwarding service, or UPS store). A signed Consent to Appointment by Registered Agent must accompany the filing. Online filers certify they hold one.

Step 3: File your Articles of Organization

File your Articles of Organization with the Wyoming Secretary of State, Business Division. You can file online at <https://wyobiz.wyo.gov/Business/RegistrationInstr.aspx> or by mail. The filing fee is \$100 for both methods. If you file online and pay by credit card, a 2.4% processing fee (minimum \$1) applies.

Step 4: Create an operating agreement

Create an operating agreement to outline ownership, roles, voting procedures, and what happens if a member leaves.

Step 5: Get your EIN from the IRS

Get your Employer Identification Number (EIN) from the IRS for free at <https://www.irs.gov/ein>.

Step 6: Keep your LLC in good standing

File an Annual Report each year by the first day of the anniversary month of formation. You may file up to 120 days early. The cost is the Annual Report License Tax, which is \$60 or two-tenths of one mill on the dollar (\$.0002) of assets located and employed in Wyoming, whichever is greater. This is a single payment that covers both the annual report fee and the franchise/minimum tax. Online filing adds a 2.4% credit card processing fee (minimum \$1). E-filing is not permitted if the fee exceeds \$500. Failure to file within 60 days of the due date results in dissolution.

Frequently asked questions

How much does it cost to form an LLC in Wyoming?

The filing fee is \$100. If you pay online with a credit card, add a 2.4% processing fee (minimum \$1).

When is the annual report due?

The Annual Report is due on the first day of the anniversary month of formation each year. It may be filed up to 120 days early.

What is the cost of the Wyoming annual report?

The cost is the Annual Report License Tax, which is \$60 or \$.0002 per dollar of assets located and employed in Wyoming, whichever is greater. This is one payment that includes the franchise/minimum tax.

Can I be my own registered agent in Wyoming?

Yes, if you are at least 18, reside in Wyoming, and have a physical Wyoming address (not a PO box or similar service).

How long does it take to process an LLC filing in Wyoming?

Online filings result in an entity that is active immediately. Mailed documents are reviewed in the order received, with a maximum processing time of fifteen (15) business days.
